<u>Congregational Meeting for Information and Discussion about</u> <u>Becoming Open and Affirming, Today after Refreshments</u> Our congregation voted unanimously on May 21st to continue to the next stage of our Open and Affirming process. Our task now is to explore what happens when a congregation becomes officially open to and affirming of people of all sexual orientations and gender identities and expressions. Today after refreshments we will look at what other congregations have experienced and discuss a draft of what could become our Open and Affirming Covenant and Implementation Plan.

Mission Committee Update: Supporting Oxfam with an Amazing

Bonus! Recently, on behalf of our church, we were honored to support Oxfam which states their mission this way: "Oxfam is a global organization that fights inequality to end poverty and injustice.
