Mission Committee Update: Honoring World Central Kitchen Workers and Help for Haiti

We gratefully received an anonymous donation given in memory of **Ken and Marcia Bushnell**. We will use it to spread the love and kindness that Ken and Marcia showed to all.... The death of seven **World Central Kitchen** workers who were delivering desperately needed meals in Gaza was heartbreaking. On behalf of the church, we sent a donation in honor of those heroes as well as to honor *all* of the brave WCK workers who serve in dangerous areas.... The violent and disturbing situation in Haiti has also been on our minds. We made a donation to **Partners in Health**, providing care for so many in Haiti. Before this conflict, one in five children was starving but this number is likely larger now. PIH makes a peanut based nutritional supplement to restore malnourished children to health. They know the starving child will be okay when they finally smile.
